- Use correct chemicals as required for cleaning tasks
- Carry out deep cleaning and detailed cleaning tasks were needed
- Clean filters of washing machines and tumble dryers as required
- Prioritise a variety of different cleaning tasks to ensure cleaning is complete by opening deadline
- Use creative thinking to identify and resolve problems through following established cleaning procedures
- Maintain stocks and supplies or cleaning products
- Stock and maintain hand sanitisers, soap dispensers and paper towel holders
- Follow all health and safety regulations as instructed
