Main Purpose of the role:

The Finance Officer role is responsible for managing the day-to-day aspects of the finance function, supporting all areas of financial operations including processes, systems and controls. The role will also provide expert financial support, information and guidance to non-finance colleagues across the organisation.

Key Tasks

Financial Processing

- Manage all financial processing assisted by the Finance Assistant, including:
 - Process supplier invoices via DEXT PREPARE, ensuring all coding is accurate including the correct VAT treatment is adhered to in order to ensure VAT can be effectively recovered where appropriate
 - Review daily the invoices pending authorisation via APPROVALMAX to ensure all invoices are approved in a timely manner
 - Review daily rejected invoices and take appropriate action with the approver to resubmit and process the rejected invoices to ensure timely payment
 - \circ $\;$ Process weekly payment runs for the charity and its trading subsidiary

- Process all credit card expenditure ensuring all invoices, receipts and supporting documentation have been received
- Process all employee and volunteer expense claims ensuring all are fully receipted and approved by the appropriate line manager
- \circ $\;$ Raise Sales invoices in XERO on behalf of the fundraising and commercial teams
- Organise and manage the weekly collection and recording of takings (cash and non-cash) from the commercial outlets and cash from the on-site collection points and ensure they are ready for collection by the Security company.
- Monitor, reconcile and replenish all cash floats across the site and provide support to the commercial outlets offsite to ensure adequate cash floats are maintained
- Liaising with the fundraising team, process and reconcile all cash and online donations received from the different income sources on a weekly basis
- Provide finance support and guidance to non-finance employees on financial procedures, policies and finance regulations.
- Lead on the month end close processes including monthly accruals, prepayments, closing stock and stock transfers.
- Reconcile monthly all balance sheet control accounts, across all areas of financial accounting (charitable, commercial and business activities) including bank, cash, accounts payable and receivable, payroll, stock, VAT and intercompany accounts.
- Ensure accurate recording and accounting treatment of restricted donation income and expenditure.
- Submit the gift aid claim for the Commercial outlets on a monthly process and ensure income is corrected allocated in XERO.
- Liaise with the fundraising team re the timely and accurate submission of the quarterly gift aid claim for fundraising donations.
- Maintain the fixed asset register and ensure all additions, disposals and depreciation are accurately recorded.

Statutory compliance

- Prepare the quarterly VAT returns, including partial exemption calculations, ready for submission to HMRC.
- Support the Head of Finance and Resources with the annual audit process, preparing lead schedules and liaising with the auditors during the interim and final audit, responding to information requests.

Payroll and Pensions

- Prepare the monthly payroll file, liaising with HR. Ensure all payroll and pension data is complete and accurate and submit to the payroll bureau. Review all payroll reports received from the payroll bureau and ensure are complete and accurate prior to approval of the payroll by the Head of Finance and Resources and Chief Executive.
- Ensure correct allocation of staff costs to departments and process the monthly payroll journal in XERO.

- Act as lead contact with the HR team to resolve any payroll and pension administration queries raised by employees.
- Support with the pension administration, including opt out by employees and submission of monthly data to the People's Pension.

Financial Reporting and analysis

- Support the Head of Finance and Resources with cashflow management and the review and update of the monthly cash flow forecast.
- Support the Head of Finance and Resources with the production of monthly management accounts and variance analysis.
- Provide financial information, advice and guidance to the cost centre managers to support them with the financial management of their sections and to assist them with the preparation of their quarterly forecasts and annual budget.
- Support the Head of Finance and Resources with the quarterly forecast and annual budget process.

Provide cost data and analysis when requested by the Fundraising Team in support of grant and trust applications.

Operational

- Manage the regular review of and update of finance policies and procedures in the Finance handbook ensuring they reflect actual current operations within the finance function and comply with relevant legislation and best practice to avoid and prevent error and fraud.
- Support with the administration of contract renewals including the annual insurance policies.
- Proactively contribute to the development of our systems, processes and procedures, to increase efficiencies in the way we work.

People Management

- Take responsibility for the management of the Finance Assistant in accordance with standard procedures.
- To provide training, motivation, support and supervision to the Finance Assistant
- Regular review and performance management of the Finance Assistant
- Responsible for the proper implementation of HR policies and procedures relating to staff

Other

- Observe Raystede's working policies at all times, including those on Health and Safety and Equal Opportunities
- Undertake, from time to time, other duties that may be required to support the effectiveness and wider aims of the charity
- Contribute to the overall success of Raystede and support a positive culture through teamwork, communication and leadership
